



## Nighttime Work Scheduled

**Weeks of March 26 – 30 and April 2 – 6**  
**8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.**

Over the next two weeks (March 26 - 30 and April 2 - 6) there will be nighttime work. Working their way from the west side of the bridge (Lair Hill) to the east side (South Waterfront), crews will **remove temporary overhang forms and brackets on the bridge that were used to place the concrete deck**. The work is expected to take at least one week and could continue into the following week.

Crews will also **secure the new concrete barrier to the roadway pavement on SW Hood Avenue** between the Ross Island Bridge and SW Curry Street.

Nearby neighbors should expect **nighttime noise as crews use drills to place pins in the barrier**, as well as noise from trucks, generators for lights, and equipment.

**Roadway closures are expected to change each night**. The contractor will be closing lanes of SW Hood Avenue, northbound and southbound I-5, northbound and southbound I-405, and SW Macadam Avenue that are below or near the area of work. Motorists should follow signed detour routes.

Progress on the bridge continues. The concrete bridge deck has cured and the ornamental bridge railing and fencing are being installed. Sidewalk improvements on the west side of the bridge are nearing completion. **Please check our web site for more bridge updates and stay tuned for plans for a Grand Opening!**

March 26<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup>  
April 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>

**DETOUR ROUTES:**

- Motorists should **look for detour signs** to aid their travel during the week, since the lanes and roads that will be closed will change each night of the week.
- **Crews will work from west to east on the bridge deck**, closing lanes of SW Hood Avenue, northbound and southbound I-5, northbound and southbound I-405, and SW Macadam Avenue, that are below or near the area of work.
